

## Mi Familia Project

You will be completing a project about your family. The Project will have 3 parts. The entire project will count as **one project grade**.

Part 1: Writing Section - you will complete this section in class.

Part 2: Product – a poster, google slides, or a scrap book of your family tree.

Part 3: Presentation – you will present your family tree to the class (in Spanish!)

### Part 1: Writing

You will write a paper about your family. **All papers should start with you.** Include the following when writing about yourself:

- Your name
- How old you are
- Physical description
- Character description
- What you like to do

Then begin writing about your family members. Include the following information:

- Their name and relation to you
- Their age
- Physical description
- Use two adjectives to describe their personality
- One thing that they like to do

Part 2: Product – a poster, google slides, or a scrap book of your family tree.

The **poster, google slides, or scrap book** of your family tree should include photos that are visible. Each person should be labeled with their name and relation to you in Spanish. This means that you will use possessive adjectives (mi/mis). The labels should be large and neatly typed or written. \* When you label yourself, use “yo”. There should not be any other writing on your project other than the names and the relationship of the people pictured. You need to begin with your grandparents and work your way down to yourself and your siblings. You may include aunts, uncles and cousins. You must include a minimum of 6 people on your poster, google slides or scrapbook (this includes yourself). If you choose to make a poster/scrapbook, you must have your full name on the back.

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Part 3: Presentation

Choose 4 of the family members from your poster, google slides, or scrapbook and be prepared to speak about them on **Tuesday, October 19<sup>th</sup>**. You may not have note cards or read anything during your presentation. Doing so will result in loss of **all the credit** for the presentation. Do not use English. Say everything in Spanish. You must include the following information when speaking:

- Their name and relationship to you (Don es mi abuelo.)
- 1 sentence giving a physical description.
- 1 sentence about their personality.
- 1 sentence telling what they like or dislike
- 1 sentence – your choice (you may expand on their physical appearance, their personality, or add another like/dislike.)

You will say 5 sentences about each person. Each sentence will be worth 2 points. Small error will result in 1 point. Major error or omission of the sentence will result in loss of points. You can have a total of 40 points.
