1. Chronic - marked by long duration or frequent recurrence
2. Contemporary - existing in the same time period; one of the same age as another
3. Temperamental - marked by excessive sensitivity and impulsive changes of mood
4. Tempest - a violent storm; an uproar
5. Chronicle - a usually continuous historical account; to list, describe
6. Synchronize - to happen at the same time
7. Temperance - moderation in action, thought, or feeling
8. Tempo - rate of motion or activity, pace
9. Chronological - arranged according to the order of time
10. Temper - to dilute or qualify; calmness of mind, composure
11. Unbreakable - not able to be broken
12. Disabled - impaired or limited by a physical, mental, cognitive, or developmental condition.
13. Unreliable - not reliable
14. Distrustful - having or showing distrust
15. Unclassified - not subject to a security classification; not placed or belonging in a class
16. Immobile - not moving; motionless
17. Mishandled - to treat roughly; to deal with or manage wrongly or ignorantly
18. Unbearable - not bearable; unendurable
19. Dishonesty - lack of honesty or integrity; disposition to defraud or deceive
20. Untainted - not contaminated, spoiled, or affected slightly with something bad.
